- 1) The applicant agrees to pay a service charge for tapping the water main, with said service charge to be paid at the time of signing this application.
- 2) The applicant agrees to pay for the materials and labor used to connect this service from, and including, the curb stop to the place of service.
- 3) The applicant agrees to pay a one-time-only, non-refundable meter use fee to Pascoag Utility District in the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_.
- 4) The applicant agrees to pay a quarterly meter maintenance fee to cover any repair and/or replacement (including labor) of said water meter.
- 5) The applicant agrees to pay for all costs associated with the repair and/or replacement of water service lines and associated appurtenances (except the water meter), from, and including, the curb stop (shutoff near road), to the applicant's end point of use.
- 6) The applicant agrees to pay any and all charges incurred for digging.
- 7) The applicant agrees to provide and pay for any necessary blasting.
- 8) The Pascoag Utility District will not perform or be responsible for grading or landscape work in connection with installing, maintaining or repairing water service connections.
- 9) The applicant hereby grants all rights of easement to the Pascoag Utility District in connection with installing, maintaining or repairing of water service connection, and agrees to execute any and all documents reasonably necessary to record or perfect such easement.
- 10) If at any time the water is shut off for nonpayment of water bills, or for any reason for which the Water Department is not responsible, there will be a service charge for restoring the service.
- 11) The applicant agrees to pay all costs associated with the purchase of water as approved by the Board of Utility Commissioners from time to time, including hydrant assessment fees, and cost associated with exploration and production of new water sources as charged to all customers taking water service from the company.
- 12) I acknowledge that I have received a copy of Pascoag Utility District's Rule and Regulations.

<sup>3</sup> The rate structure was constructed using a single family residential development as the base unit for calculating the rate formula. In light of the foregoing and because non-residential connections may range from very low use to very high use, a non-residential applicant may seek an appropriate adjustment from a strict application of the rate chart per unit formula based on estimated, typical usage for such connections. Nevertheless, for size of line categories 1 through 2 inch, the base fee rates set forth in the chart for each of these categories are considered the minimum for a non-residential development employing these connections line sizes. In addition, in part because of the substantial range of the potential volume of water which could be transmitted by lines in excess of 2 inches, in determining the appropriate connection fee rate for a non-residential connection, the rate structure permits the District to also take into account, among other things, the size of the service connection, the number of units, and the estimated or projected water usage of the new or expanded connection in accordance with any standards, guidelines, and/or methodology reasonable relied upon in the water service industry for determining or estimating water usage. The minimum connection fee, however, for commercial applications whether for hydrant use or potable water supply will be based on \$1,000/inch per diameter of the requested line, over a 1" inch line.

<sup>4</sup> To eliminate any incentive for an applicant to propose a smaller size of line than that provided in the chart for the number of units in the proposed development, the rate set forth in the chart for the number of residential units will prevail over size of line
